Hello everyone,

This week we start harvest services and events around the Benefice. As most of you know, our harvest celebrations this year will be slightly different in most of our churches: events to encourage participation from the wider community as traditional harvest services no longer seem to attract people as they used to. At Ardley (26/9, 9.30am), Fritwell (3/10, 9.30am), Lower Heyford (10/10, 11am), Souldern (10/10, 11am) and Upper Heyford (26/9, 9.30am), we will be encouraging people from the community to bring their cans of food to the church in order to make a trail of cans from the churchyard gate to the door of the church. We hope, over the period of an hour, to produce an impressive line of various cans which will then be donated to local foodbanks. Somerton (26/9, 9.30am), will be having a traditional service and also encouraging others to attend. Souldern will also be having a Harvest Service (10/10, 11am). On Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> September, all the primary age children from Heyford Park School will be coming to the Chapel for their harvest celebration and Fritwell School children will be coming to St Olave's Churchyard at 9.15am on 1<sup>st</sup> October for theirs. A real celebration of harvest for everyone this year. Please come, and bring your friends and neighbours.

We're collecting cans only. Please don't donate loads of baked beans; foodbanks have enough of those! We're always tempted to find that tin which has been in the back of our cupboard for ages, but harvest is about saying thank you to God and giving him, through our gifts to those in need, the best we can give. If Jesus came to tea, we wouldn't be digging out that old tin! In the Bible Jesus says, "Truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family, you did it to me."
